

HOW THE MONEY WAS DISTRIBUTED TO WIDOWS

I received the sum of 502350 Francs FCFA from Mr. Christopher Eho, on March 4th of March 2013 at about 6:45 Pm then On Wednesday the 6 th of March at exactly 4:32 Pm He gave me sum of 190.000 frs which amount to 692350 frs, after he have deducted 62.000 FCFA which is the money used to pay the sending fee for the gifts to Sweden.

HOW THE MONEY WAS SHARED TO THE WIDOWS

The widows are actively thirteen (13) in numbers and upon the instruction of the board of directors, I was asked to share the money equally among them. Also, because of their different business ideas, each of them was given 40.000 Frs. to add to their already existing petit business or farming occupation.

THEIR VARIOUS BUSINESS IDEAS

Every widow involves in business according to their strength, there widows who can still do some kind of a little bit of more demanding business but there are others who cannot or rather who can just do something their fingers can help them to do. Among the 13 active members I met, there are farmers who cultivate different kinds of food stuffs like, tomatoes, cocoyams, green spices cassava, etc... they cultivate these crops harvest and sell them to raise money.

Generally, there are four (4) widows who are farmers who entirely depend on farming.

Two (2) widows who have petit provision stores running.

One (1) widow who own a restaurant, cooking and selling varieties of cooked food.

One (1) widow who is a local tailor

One (1) widow who is a fruit seller. She buys fruits from farmers and retail the fruits to the public.

One (1) widow who is engaged in the raring of livestock. Pigs and fowls.

One (1) widow who retail second handed dresses

One (1) widow who retails dry wood to women for local cuisine.

One (1) widow who Fabricate handmade shoes and typical traditional dresses and sell very traditional Cameroonians.

COMPENSATION PLAN

- ❖ Out of the 692350 frs, 40.000frs was given to Mr. Christopher, for his assistance and support to ensure that this project and ,ransaction moved successfully.
- ❖ I received the sum of 130.000frs as my payment for playing the part of a middleman between the widows and Mr. Henry of Sweden.
